USE DUST EXTRACTION, RESPECT REGULATORY OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE LIMITS FOR TOTAL INHALABLE AND RESPIRABLE DUST.

**Eye** Due to product form, irritation is not expected unless cut or heated and dust or fumes generated.
